


Atlanta Seasonal Color – Floralis Garden Design

The landscape at the residence is simple, clean-lined, and mainly evergreen. The container plantings are meant to accent the landscape, add seasonal color and bring brightness to shade-filled areas. The front entry bed and urn are filled with Saxifrage and Hellebores.


