The pursuit of cleanliness brings up another challenge during installation and ongoing maintenance. As the site incorporates a hefty volume of concrete that must remain spotless, we wear booties so that no footprints are left behind.



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During the maintenance season we maintain consistent communication with the maintenance crews to ensure that the dropped flowers are removed quickly.



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The pop of yellow during the summer creates a bright color bed with the contrast of the soothing blue.



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The back side of the property is where more calming colors are used. The textures and colors work well together to create a tranquil feeling.
